As the news media shares horrific accounts of the war in Syria, many people have left their homes to escape the tragedy. Yet one story remains untold. The tragedy has opened doors for the Gospel to be shared in ways that have never been seen, according to Christian workers in the region.

Syrians who have never heard the Gospel are finding Christians waiting to tell them in Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey.

"It is awesome to be on the edge of what God is doing," said Catherine Steel,* a Christian worker in the Middle East.
