BREAKING THE PARENT CODE!

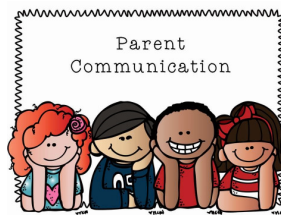
~ Starting a conversation ~

Take your child (or children) out with the idea of finding out how they are doing. Let them pick their favorite place.

Avoid asking "yes/no" or "good/fine" questions. Instead ask questions that get them talking. Instead of, "How's your friend?" ask "Tell me one thing that made you happy this week."

(HINT: Don't freak out if they open up.)

*"These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Deut. 6:6-7"*
